BY THE COURT:

In compliance with our order and writ of mandamus issued on February 27, 2008, the district court has issued an order addressing Petitioners' claims of associational privilege. The district court concluded that Petitioners had not made a prima facie showing that they will suffer any infringement of associational rights if they provide Defendants with the disputed discovery. Because Petitioners have not demonstrated that the district court's conclusion was an abuse of discretion, the "Renewed Petition for Writ of Mandamus..." is DENIED.
