
ORDER

Previously, the Eleventh Circuit directed this Court to enter an order clarifying whether the Court had considered Plaintiffs' claims of associational privilege in ruling on Defendants' motion to compel. On June 20, 2008, the Court entered an order in response to the direction of the Eleventh Circuit. Subsequently, Plaintiffs filed a renewed petition for writ of mandamus with the Eleventh Circuit, and the Court stayed and administratively closed this case pending resolution of Plaintiffs' renewed petition. The Court directed the parties that they could move to reopen this case within ten (10) days of the issuance of a ruling by the Eleventh Circuit.

The Eleventh Circuit denied Plaintiffs' renewed petition on September 24, 2008. Neither party, however, moved to reopen this case. Accordingly,

the Court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to **REOPEN** this case, **VACATE** the Court's September 28, 2006, Preliminary Injunction Order [# 37] and **DISMISS** Plaintiff's Complaint **without prejudice**. The Court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to **CLOSE** this case.
