

## POLLING PLACE LOCATIONS

Advancement Project also conducted research on the criteria used to select the location of polling places. Overall, the counties used the same criteria, which are as follows:<sup>9</sup>

1. Check for a convenient location that is easily accessible and in the precinct boundaries. One location may be used for multiple precincts depending on the size of the location and the precincts.
2. The size of the location must be adequate to accommodate the expected number of voters. Expected number is based upon previous turnout. The Board of Elections tries to keep the precinct size below 1,500 voters.
3. Location must be in compliance with the American with Disabilities Act (ADA).
4. Must have adequate parking for voters.
5. Location must have a telephone that poll workers can use.
