  - Expected salary is \$11,000 for the president and \$10,000 for other regular members
    - Set by legislature, paid through city budget

- Expected salary is \$4,000 for the president and \$3,000 for other regular members
  - Set by legislature, paid through County budget

- Set by legislature, paid through County budget
