The amount is calculated as follows: (1) \$85 for each full one thousand of the first one hundred thousand population; (2) \$40.50 for each full one thousand of the second one hundred thousand population; (3) \$22 for each full one thousand of the third one hundred thousand population; (4) \$6.75 for each full one thousand above three hundred thousand population. The compensation of a member of the board shall not be less than \$3,075 and shall not exceed \$20,000 annually.
